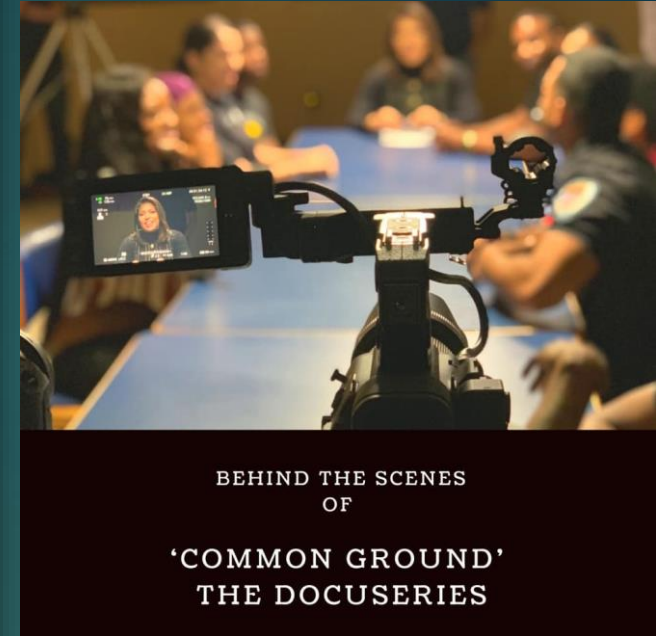

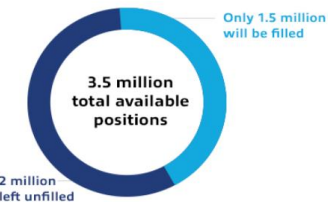

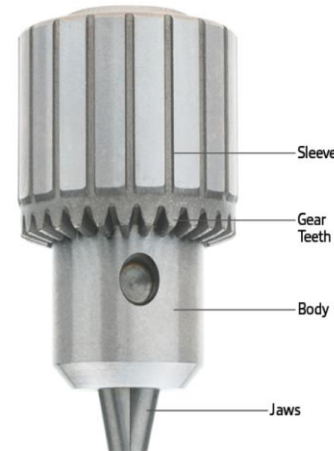

TECH ESSENTIALS DRILL CHUCKS



Drill chucks are devices used to hold a drill or other cutting tools on a spindle. They are available in keyed, keyless or hybrid systems, allowing for quick changes of a drill bit.

DIAGRAM OF A DRILL CHUCK



Key Styles:

Keyed chucks are engineered to either loosen or tighten the hold on a tool by using a key. Keyed chucks offer the advantage of applying additional torque on the bit when slippage is a concern during heavy-duty applications.

Keyless chucks are engineered to quickly loosen and tighten a tool on the chuck collar of the drill, either by manual operation or when torque is applied. Rotating the chuck collar in a counterclockwise direction will loosen the tool.

Hybrid drill chucks are engineered with both keyed and keyless systems. The keyless portion automatically tightens, while the keyed portion is adjusted on the chuck to offer added gripping and torque support on the tool.

Mount type refers to how the drill chuck connects to an arbor, shank or spindle.

Integral Shank drill chucks are designed with the arbor (shank) built into the drill chuck, providing greater rigidity and concentricity than a press-fit tapered mount.

Tapered Mount drill chucks have an internal Jacobs Taper (JT) that is press-fit onto a corresponding JT arbor (shank) or spindle.

Threaded Mount drill chucks have an internal thread for securing to a power drill spindle or a threaded arbor.

The Barrier Between Hollywood and the Independent: A harsh view from a Long Island Filmmaker - Excerpt

The rage against the Hollywood machine, independent filmmaker Fred Carpenter has been punching, clawing and attempting to pry open the steel barrier that has kept out his Hollywood arrival for over a decade. With the independent market flooded by anyone that has a few hundred dollars and a camera, to big name actors appearing in their own low budget productions, the competition has forced Carpenter to push harder than ever. "I'd like to say independent filmmaking means my own creative independence, but that's bullshit! It's about raising money to make a movie, because Hollywood isn't giving me a dime," Carpenter says.

In order for Carpenter to pursue his dream, he and his production partner Leonard Weintraub estimate how much money they can obtain before even looking at a script. Once that is established, they think about a concept that they know will sell. "That means we want to entertain the butcher, baker and the candlestick maker. You have to make a film a distributor can sell," Carpenter explains. "They don't give a shit how artsy it is, they ask themselves if they can sell it."

Carpenter adds that when a studio makes a movie and they find a script that is under \$50 million, they are already in the black and won't lose. "Ya' think about this shit. I gotta' be nuts," he says. "I'm making a car in my backyard with my friends and I think I'm gonna' compete with General Motors."

To make things more difficult for himself, Carpenter punches the keys on a typewriter when designing a screenplay and has to run down to the library if he wants to see his new web site. The director has yet to enter the world of telecommunication. He does not e-mail, carries no palm pilot, beeper or cell phone.

The Sisterhood of Temple Emanu-El of Lynbrook hosted guest speaker, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, at their Shabbat Service on Friday, February 11.

Making her way into Saperstein Plaza in Lynbrook after speaking at Adelphi University and C.W. Post about lowering tuition costs, entered the temple sanctuary and walked down the aisle towards the Bima while over 1000 congregants waited in anticipation for her speech. Several minutes before Hillary Clinton, a New York State Senate candidate, would even utter a single word she was greeted by a wave of applause. As the service ended and Rabbi Stuart Gellar acknowledged the First Lady's presence, a timid applause rose from the rear and quickly spread throughout the hundreds of men and women in attendance. During his introduction, Rabbi Gellar referred to Ms. Clinton's keynote address at a convention of the Union of American Hebrew Foreign Nations in 1993 in San Francisco, California. He said that 5000 delegates attended the event where she spoke on the health care crisis the nation was facing.

"Mrs. Clinton is not the first candidate to address this congregation from this pulpit," Rabbi Gellar said. "We feel that in bringing a political candidate to our congregation we educate ourselves and in away we educate the candidate about what we are thinking. "Although Ms. Clinton said she was not going to talk about politics, she did say a few words about community values, religion, healthcare and the educational need of children.

"I have always made it a point to speak out about the importance of religious tolerance," Ms. Clinton said. "I think that the important value of religious freedom and religious tolerance is one that we in America constantly must speak out about."
